

## JUSTIN DILLON

Justin Dillon is a partner at KaiserDillon PLLC in Washington, D.C. Mr. Dillon has gained nationwide attention for his work representing students and professors in campus misconduct cases, which he and his firm have handled at more than 100 schools across the country.

Mr. Dillon was the first lawyer in the country to win summary judgment against a university in a campus sexual assault case, and he has been published or quoted regarding campus sexual misconduct issues in more than a dozen national newspapers and magazines, including *The Wall Street Journal*, *The New York Times*, *The Washington Post*, and *The Los Angeles Times*.

Mr. Dillon has also spoken on these issues before organizations such as the American Bar Association, the Association of Title IX Administrators, the National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers, and the University of Kentucky's Center for Research on Violence Against Women.

Immediately before joining KaiserDillon, Mr. Dillon spent five and a half years as an Assistant United States Attorney in Washington, D.C. Earlier in his career, he worked at the Civil Rights Division of the U.S. Department of Justice.

Mr. Dillon is a graduate of Duke University, where he was editor-in-chief of the daily campus newspaper, and of Harvard Law School, where he served as an editor of the *Harvard Law Review*.
